Dear CCS Senior High Families,

CCS has received approval from Manatee County – State of Florida to participate in the Dual Enrollment of State College of Florida (SCF). This means that Sophomore through Senior students may apply for the Dual Enrollment Program (which allows a senior high student at CCS to earn high school and college credit when taking a course at SCF).

There are certain requirements that CCS and SCF have in order for a student to enroll in the program:

Community Christian School

- Be classified at least as a Sophomore
- Have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Be able to enrolled full time at CCS
- Have administrative approval for enrolling and for the selection of courses

State College of Florida

- Be classified at least as a Sophomore
- Have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA as well as maintaining a 3.0 while dual enrolled
- Have a passing score on a qualifying test – ACT, SAT, or CPT (College Placement Test)
- Be able to meet the SCF required deadlines for enrollment
- Complete the ‘Application for Early College’ form
- Complete the ‘High School Early College Approval’ form
- Receive required approval from parent, high school, and college
