

COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL NURSERY - 12TH GRADE REGISTRATION 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Prospective Family,

Thank you for your interest in Community Christian School (CCS)! Since 1968 the school has been educating children in and around Manatee County. **CCS has been continuously accredited since the 1970's.** Nationally, the school is accredited by the *American Association of Christian Schools (AACCS)*. Regionally, CCS is accredited by the *North American Christian School Accrediting Agency (NACSAA)*, which is recognized by the state of Florida. The school and childcare are certified through the *Sunshine State Association of Christian Schools (SSACS)*.

Please find included with this letter: applications, tuition/fee sheets, calendar information, and a parent student handbook. CCS is a ministry of Community Baptist Church and reflects the purposes and intents of the church. The primary purpose of CCS is to provide a Christian education with a strong academic emphasis. The purpose of the school is to see children receive Jesus Christ as Savior, learn to live for Him, and receive a traditional academic education.

In order to enroll, all paperwork must be completed and returned with the appropriate fee. Also, each child, K5 through 12th grade, desiring to be enrolled must take an academic entrance test. After all items have been completed, you will be notified of the school's decision about enrollment.

1. Schedule an interview with the administrator. Please bring the following
 - ◆ One or two years of achievement testing.
 - ◆ One or two years of report cards.
 - ◆ If a senior high student, a credit transcript of courses and grades.
2. **Registration Fees** must accompany all enrollment paperwork. Otherwise registration is not complete and a place cannot be held for your child.
 - ◆ For K5-12th grade students – The registration fee is \$150 per child.
 - ◆ For Nursery-K4 students – The registration fee is \$80 per child.
3. **Tuition information:**
 - a. Tuition paid monthly is due by the 1st of each month.
 - b. A \$25 late charge is applied for payments received after the 10th.
 - c. If payment is not made by the 15th, the child will not be allowed to attend school until payment is made or an arrangement for payment is made.
 - d. **Preschool tuition:**
 - ◆ Monthly rates will be charged regardless of the number of days attended. (Monthly rates will be pro-rated by the week ONLY for the first and last month of a student's attendance.)
 - ◆ If a child is absent for more than two consecutive weeks the child will be dropped from the roll unless prior arrangements have been made.
 - ◆ Paying weekly requires paying one month's tuition (four extra weeks) **before August 1st.**
 - e. **K5 – 12th grade tuition:**

- ◆ Tuition and fees are paid on a 10 month payment schedule from August to May.
 - ◆ To receive a paid-in-full 4% discount, all tuition must be paid by September 1, 2010.
 - ◆ The tuition fees include all textbook rental fees (this helps spread out the textbook fees over the school year instead of one large payment at the beginning of the school year).
The tuition fees for 7th-12th students also include the cost for the annual retreat.
- f. **Extended Care Fees** for K5-6th are due on a monthly basis (\$150 for one student and \$225 for 2 students). Extended care is provided for those who need it on a regular basis and is *not for occasional use*.
- g. **The Capital Improvement Fund fee** is \$200 per family, per school year. This fee is for facility and property improvements.

4. **Basic information about the school:**

- ◆ CCS enrolls Nursery through 12th grade students.
- ◆ Nursery childcare is for 6 weeks to twenty-four month of age.
- ◆ Phonics is taught in all K2 - 2nd grade classes.
- ◆ Class sizes range from 12 to 25 per class.
- ◆ *ABeka* and *Bob Jones University Press* Christian school curriculums are used from K2 to 12th grade.
- ◆ Choir music is taught from K5 through 12th grade. Band is required from 6th through 8th grade and taught in 9th through 12th grade. All music is conservative in nature.
- ◆ The junior/senior high sports program includes volleyball, soccer, basketball, and golf.
- ◆ Students in 4th through 12th grade compete in Fine Arts programs.
- ◆ We offer students in 3rd through 6th grade a spring intramural sports program that includes soccer and basketball.
